

AUDITIONS FOR SPRING PRODUCTION

Auditions for our spring show, *Crimes of the Heart*, will be held at the theater starting at 7pm on Sunday, December 10 and Monday December 11, 2017. All parts are available and anyone interested is invited to attend. No particular preparation is required. We will be doing some improvisation to judge your acting abilities and maybe some cold reading of the script.

The actors all have southern US accents, so that will help, but if you do not have one, we will be willing to teach you. If you would like to test your acting chops and be a part of a truly meaningful production, please come to auditions.

Crimes of the Heart by Beth Henley is the winner of a Pulitzer Prize, the New York Drama Critics Circle Award for Best New American Play and a Guggenheim Award, as well as a Tony nomination. This tragicomedy relates the story of the three Magrath sisters, Meg, Babe, and Lenny, who reunite at Old Granddaddy's home in Hazlehurst, Mississippi, after Babe shoots her abusive husband. The sisters were raised in a dysfunctional family with a penchant for ugly predicaments. Each has endured her share of hardship and misery. Past resentments bubble to the surface as the sisters are forced to deal with assorted relatives and past relationships while coping with Babe's latest incident. Each sister is forced to face the consequences of the "crimes of the heart" she has committed.

This production will be directed by Carol Bense, with Bob Tuttle assisting. Joshua Spaulding is producing and Jay Sydow will create the set. Performances will be April 6, 7, 13, 14, 15, 2018.

The roles for this show are:

Lenny Macgrath - (f 30) the oldest sister who has stayed at home and cared for Old Grandad

Meg Macgrath - (f 27) the middle sister who went off to California to pursue a singing career

Babe Botrelle - (f 24) the youngest sister who has married a successful lawyer, and shot him

Doc Porter - (m 30) Meg's old boyfriend who has his own wife and children but remains close to the Macgrath family Barnett Lloyd - (m 26) Babe's lawyer, an ambitious, talented attorney who views Babe's case as a chance to exact his personal revenge on Zackery

Chick Boyle - (f 29) The sister's first cousin a very demanding relative, extremely concerned about the community's opinion of her
