Guidelines for Village Players Scholarship

Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students who have shown an interest in the arts and who intend to pursue higher education.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a senior in high school and must be planning to continue his or her education in a post-secondary institution. Those planning to major in some form of the arts will be given priority, but the scholarship is also available to others who have shown an interest in the arts and intend to pursue some form of the arts in their adult life. Scholarships are generally awarded to students from nearby high schools or students who have been active in The Village Players in some way.

Deadline: Scholarship applications must be post-marked by the last Monday in November to be considered for the following year.

Award: The monetary award will be decided by the Village Players Board and will be granted directly to the student in his or her second semester of post-secondary education. Once chosen for the award, the student must submit a copy of his/her first semester transcript the following January or February to show that he/she will be continuing into the second semester.

Communication: Applications and all other documentation, including the transcript of the successful applicant, must be mailed to The Village Players at the address above.

Application: Must be on the Village Players Application Form. Please include at least one letter of recommendation. Should also include any documentation that you think might help the board decide on your qualifications for this scholarship. (Hint – typewritten applications are easier to read, but hand-written applications will be accepted.)
